Linda Meyerholz Appears on WGPU's Gulf Coast Live

Linda addresses topic of violence in the aftermath of the Virginia Tech tragedy

FORT MYERS, Fla. (April 24, 2007) – Local author and licensed therapist Linda Meyerholz, MS, LMHC, was a guest on WGPU's afternoon radio show Gulf Coast Live as part of a panel discussion on violence in the aftermath of the Virginia Tech massacre.

The April 16 tragedy became the largest mass-murder in America's history when Korean-American Seung-Hui Cho, a Virginia Tech student, shot and killed 30 students and faculty members and wounded more than 20 others.

On the show, hosted by Luis Rodriguez and airing from 1 to 2 p.m., Linda discussed the sources of anger among men and the Korean culture, and strategies for Americans to cope with the tragedy without succumbing to fear and anger.
